UTERUS PATTERN SUPPLIES

4 mm hook

#4 medium worsted acrylic yarn 24" of a contrasting yarn for face

Stitch marker, scissors, yarn needle, two 6" pipe cleaners, polyester fill

ABBREVIATIONS ch: chain; R: round; sc: single crochet; blo: back loop only; sl st: slip stitch; sc2tog: decrease by 1;
* * #x: repeat instructions between as many times as indicated
